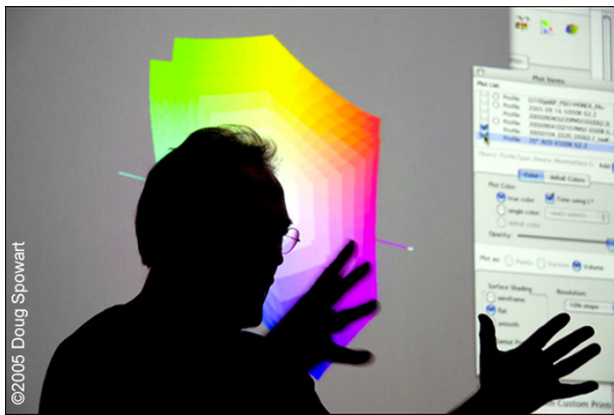


# Orpheus Island Photography Workshop 2012

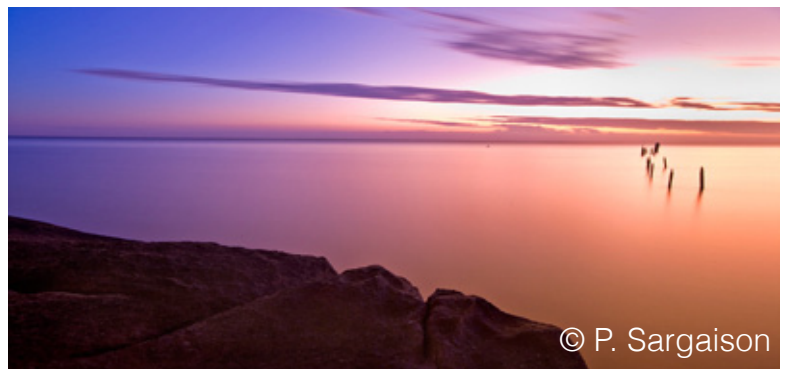
